After establishing The Dalmore and running it for 28 years, Alexander Matheson decided in 1867 it was time to pass on the distillery to new owners. Andrew and Charles Mackenzie stepped forward, bringing with them not only the iconic 12-pointed Royal Stag emblem, which has adorned every bottle of The Dalmore since, but also a formidable desire for success. Their passion for creating an even better whisky would fuel a whole new era for The Dalmore.

TASTING NOTES

Aroma: Sweet red berries, Seville oranges, plummy fruits and sticky toffee pudding

Palate: Nectarines, creamy caramel, roasted chestnuts and Java coffee

Finish: Rich plums, sultanas, Sanguinello blood oranges and macerated cherries

PRODUCTION NOTES

The Dalmore Port Wood Reserve starts its journey in the finest American white oak ex-bourbon casks. The precious liquid is then split equally with half of the whisky remaining in the American white oak and the remainder transferred to aged Tawny Port pipes from W & J Graham's vineyard in Portugal. They are then married back together to harmonise the flavours before bottling.
